



What is CORE:

CORE is a national non profit that provides financial grants to food and beverage service employees with children when either the employee, spouse or child faces a health crisis, or natural disaster.

FAQ's:

- 83% of grants are for a medical crisis
- 8% are for a natural disaster
- More than 50% are for single parents
- 3 out of 4 grants are for women
- CORE grants in all 50 states, D.C. and Puerto Rico
- Grants may cover rent/mortgage – which they pay directly, living expenses, medical needs and more
- CORE was founded to take care of our industry's children

Grant qualifications:

- Applicant must work in any type of foodservice or beverage service operation
- Employee must have at least 1 legally dependent child living at home
- Employee, spouse, or child has a medical diagnosis (documentation is required), major injury, death or loss of home or place of work due to a natural disaster
