- **Granted to employees with children in all 50 states, D.C., and Puerto Rico**
- **72% of grantees are persons of color**
- **7% of grantees speak primarily Spanish**
- **3 out of 4 grantees are women**
- **62% of grantees are single parents: 60% single moms, 2% single dads**
- **CORE grants may cover rent/mortgage, utilities, childcare, prescriptions, medical supplies, etc.**
